#### **Wize Up**





We have received reports from the LEA that these stickers are being posted around Havering advertising the selling of cannabis / cannabis-based products online. The sticker includes a QR code which takes you straight to the site. Please do not scan this code.

'From a policing perspective a report to the local policing team with locations and picture would ensure a detailed intelligence report can be completed that may link into ongoing police investigations.

Policing advise is that these QR codes should never be scanned, and local authority teams should remove them promptly.

These types of stickers have appeared nationally and are well reported in the media – often appearing near schools and even on police stations. They can even be scams as well as tactics from people involved in drug supply.'
